Speakers

Melanie Helmuth introduced our guest speakers – Luke Gascho and Levi Moser. Luke Gascho, now retired, was Executive Director of Goshen College's Merry Lea Environmental Center for 22 years. Levi Moser, 2024 graduate of Goshen High School, has been working with AmeriCorps, part time during the school year and full time this summer. They spoke on Agro-Forestry, with Gascho describing Agro-Forestry on his 2 ½ acres on Kercher Road, and

After a brief history of the land we live on (before the arrival of European settlers), Gascho listed types of Agro-Forestry – Windbreaks, Riparian, Silvopasture, Alley Cropping, Forest Farming and Orchards. His Half-Moon Rising acreage uses Alley Cropping and he showed pictures of the area as it has developed since 2013.

Moser describing recent efforts to re-establish Agro-Forestry at Vista Medical Center in Goshen, and here at Abshire Park. We ended with a walking tour of the established area at Abshire Park.
