

Call the Indiana Underground Plant Protection Service (IUPPS) before you dig. Please call at least 2 days before you begin your project and follow these steps:

- Outline your project with white paint
 Call IUPPS at 1-800-382-5544
 Know your county and township where you are digging
 Provide the name and phone number of the person digging (if not you)
 Give the utility companies time to respond
 Dig with care!
